## Baywood Colony is located in Mandatory Evacuation Zone A.

It is imperative for the safety and security of your unit and your neighbors, that all Baywood Colony villas <u>must</u> be hurricane ready when you leave for the season for seasonal residents or whenever you leave during hurricane season for full time residents. Please watch for a hurricane active on the weather map and take care of your unit accordingly.

In preparing the villa, please see the checklist on our website, and begin immediately following a **hurricane watch**, which is issued 48 hours in advance of the possibility of sustained winds above 74 mph. If the watch becomes a **hurricane warning** (sustained winds of 74 mph and higher) and the County calls for a mandatory evacuation for Zone A, the checklist should already be completed.

It is your responsibility to ensure that your unit is properly prepared and if you fail to do so, the Association will secure it at your expense.

Wind borne debris generated from loose ground materials and/or from dislodged unit components can fly an unbelievable distance and impact neighboring villas. Our villas, particularly windows, doors, and roof coverings, are at risk for impact from such high-energy, wind borne projectiles. Breaches to the villa by such projectiles will allow rainwater intrusion and subsequent damage to the building interior.
